Dear Neighbour,

I am writing to address the alarming rise in crime and disorder affecting Peterborough and our country.

Statistics Canada reports a nearly 50 percent increase in violent crime since Trudeau became Prime Minister. Homicides have risen by 28 percent, and drug-related deaths have surged by 184 percent. The London Police Chief has stated "Diverted safe supply is being resold into our community. It's being trafficked into other communities, and it is being used as currency in exchange for fentanyl, fueling the drug trade".

Since 2015, nearly 45,000 Canadians have died from drug overdoses. Over 40 percent of crimes in federal institutions are linked to substance use. Trudeau's "national decriminalization" plan could worsen the situation, as there is nothing safe about crack, fentanyl, heroin, and meth.

Trudeau's policies, such as Bill C-75 and Bill C-5, are driving this crisis. Bill C-75 allows violent repeat offenders to be released on bail, while Bill C-5 removes mandatory jail time for certain firearm offenses. Every Canadian Premier signed a letter urging the Prime Minister to end his catch-and-release bail policies to prevent further loss of life.

Additionally, funding for hard drugs has made opioids more available, impacting communities like Peterborough.

Every day, I hear from business owners and citizens concerned about the rise in crime. This crisis is a result of failed policies that Trudeau refuses to address. Inaction is the most uncompassionate response a leader can offer.

It's time for change.

The Solution:

- Repeal Bills C-75 and C-5 to keep repeat violent offenders off the streets.
- End taxpayer funding for hard drug programs and invest in treatment and recovery.
- Close Trudeau-funded facilities near families and schools under Section 56.1 of the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act.

As your MP, I am committed to restoring safety and wellness. We need a new leader who prioritizes public safety and accountability.

We need Pierre Poilievre as Prime Minister.
